DEVICE TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

FAMILY ZONE (2020 YEAR 7 TO 12)

Shalom families have access to a Family Zone **Family Pack**, which covers 3 children and 6 devices. This is paid for by the school and there is **no additional cost to parents**. By setting up a private Family Zone account, you can apply age-appropriate parental controls on every device your child has access to, in any location.

2020 YEAR 7 - SHALOM MIDDLE SCHOOL DEVICE PROGRAM (LAPTOPS)

Shalom College has implemented a change to the Middle School Device Program to commence with all Year 7 students in 2020. All Year 7 students will now receive a College Issued Laptop for use in Year 7 through to Year 9

Students will not be able to bring their own (BYO) Laptops / MacBooks or iPads for Middle School – these BYO devices will not be supported.

2020 YEARS 8 & 9 – BYO IPADS

This program will be phased out by the end of 2021 replaced with the newly implemented Middle School Device Program (Laptops) currently for Year 7 students only in 2020. **All Year 8 and Year 9 students for 2020 must bring their own (BYO) iPad.**

iPads must meet the following requirements to ensure there is no impact on classroom learning:

- Able to support the latest iOS released by Apple.
- Enough storage for college required applications (32Gb Minimum)
- Access to an iTunes account is essential. [Click here for more details](#)

Additions:

- AppleCare Extended Warranty [Click here for more information](#) (Strongly Recommended)
- Ruggedized Case to ensure the device is protected from accidental damage (Strongly Recommended)
- Bluetooth Keyboard (Optional)

Do Not Require:

- Cellular Data Service functionality.

All Student iPads that are to be used at Shalom require enrolment onto the College system. This enrolment sets up the wireless connection, the College self-service software portal and the student's email account. It allows the IT Department to manage the iPads whilst they are at the College.

2020 YEAR 10, 11 & 12

All Shalom College students entering Year 10 and continuing through to Year 12 will require a Laptop/MacBook for their senior studies. Parents can choose between one of the two following options;

Please Note: The commitment to these programs is for the duration of the student's Senior Schooling at the College.

OPTION 1: LAPTOP LEASING PROGRAM (2020 YEARS 10, 11 & 12)

Students, opting for this program offered in Year 10, will receive a Laptop device that they will use for the duration of their senior studies until the completion of Year 12.

This program is designed to assist parents and students to obtain a Laptop device compatible with the Shalom network at a very competitive price.

Other advantages include:

- Provision of all learning area and operational software
- Operating Systems Updates
- Dedicated Service Desk Support for both software and hardware
- Selected device is 'Ruggedized' with a 3-Year Warranty and three-part Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) per calendar year from HP (Hewlett Packard)
- At the end of year twelve the Laptop becomes the property of the student

End of the Laptop Leasing Program (Completion of Year 12)

- At the end of the Laptop Leasing Program, students are required to bring their Laptops to the IT Dept. to have their devices, for legal reasons, wiped of any College Licenced Software before taking ownership.

Early Termination of the Laptop Leasing Program (Students leaving Shalom before the end of year twelve)

- Students who leave the College prior to the completion of their studies in year twelve will be given the option of purchasing the laptop for the balance that is outstanding on their lease.

- Cost - \$430 / Year

OPTION 2: BYOD PROGRAM (LAPTOP) (2020 YEARS 10, 11 & 12)

This bring your own device program allows students to use their own personal Laptop devices which the College Network will support for Senior School.

Personal devices must meet the College's minimum operating standards and requirements set out below:

- Device choice – MacBook or Laptop
- Operating Systems:
 - OSX 10.8, 10.9, 10.10, 10.11

- Windows 8 or 10 (Windows 10 Education Edition is Recommended)
(Note: Windows 7 is No Longer Supported)
- Screen Size 11.6" – 15"
- Battery Life 8 ½ Hours
- Required Software - purchase of all curriculum required software for timetabled classes is expected
- Screen Mirror Support:
 - MacBook - Airplay Support
 - Laptop - Miracast Support
- (Supported by Window 8 and 10)
- Laptop hardware needs to support wireless display)

Strongly Recommended: Ruggedized Case to ensure the device is protected from accidental damage

Please be aware for the BYOD Program (Laptops) there is

- Limited Shalom IT SUPPORT AND NETWORK ACCESS
- BYOD (Laptops) do not have access to printing at the College
- Unable to install College Licenced Software onto BYOD (Laptop) devices
