Fees for 2018:

The **Trialist** form that you will sign today entitles you to **two free** training sessions.

In the 2018 year Bundaberg Rowing Club has proposed a new fee structure, which had not been confirmed at the time of printing this document. More information will be available in the new year, however the current proposal is as follows:

- 6 Months to June 30 - \$175
- Full Calendar Year to December 31 - \$350

The Shalom Rowing Supporters Group will subsidise each school rower's membership up to June 30 for the 2018 year.

Therefore each school rower would pay **\$150 only to Shalom Finance** (for the first 6 months to June 30) with the additional \$25 to be funded from Shalom Rowing funds. Obviously if paying for the full calendar year up front, it would be \$325 only.

All **NEW** rowers would also receive a **FREE Shalom Rowing Shirt and Hat**. ANY rower wanting a Jacket would need to pay \$60. All existing rowers who required a new Shirt & Hat would need to pay \$60.

Seat Fees are payable for Rowing Queensland Regattas (those held after the local Head of River) are usually between \$15-\$18 per event.

ALL FEES MUST BE PAID TO THE SHALOM COLLEGE FINANCE OFFICE.

The expectation is that rowers will have two training sessions per week
