This table of subject weights is for use by students completing Year 12 in 2019. For the purposes of determining your eligibility for an Overall Position (OP) all OP or “Authority” subjects are equally weighted at 5. Non-OP subjects have a weighting of 0.

When determining your eligibility for a Field Position (FP) subjects are weighted differently and these weightings may change from year to year. These weightings reflect the coverage of the field in the particular subject syllabus. The fields are:

Field A (FP A) - extended written expression involving complex analysis and synthesis of ideas

Field B (FP B) - short written communication involving reading, comprehension and expression in English or a foreign language

Field C (FP C) - basic numeracy involving simple calculations and graphical and tabular interpretation

Field D (FP D) - solving complex problems involving mathematical symbols and abstractions

Field E (FP E) - substantial practical performance involving physical or creative arts or expressive skills

Some subjects may be weighted 0 in one or more of the fields. Non-OP subjects have a weighting of 0 in all fields.

Important note: The information included in this table is provided for planning purposes only. Provisional statements indicating OP and FP eligibility will be distributed by both the College and the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority throughout the Senior Phase of Learning. It is the responsibility of each student to verify their OP and FP eligibility. Changing subjects during the Senior Phase of Learning may change a student’s OP and/or FP eligibility.
