Most examinations will be held in rooms Ad1 to Ad6 and Mc5 to Mc7. Actual rooming will be advised in the week prior to the start of the examination block. **All Year 12 students must attend Graduation Liturgy practice scheduled on the afternoon of Tuesday 14 November.**

Students not involved in examinations will be engaged in home study or study in the Senior covered area. The only other facility at the College that students may avail themselves of during the examination period will be the Beerarlem and the Goondeel libraries. **Access to the libraries can only be gained through prior booking.** In the event of wet weather, classrooms will be made available for study. Students may not leave the College grounds between the morning and afternoon sessions.

Students must wear full day uniform when attending examinations or other activities during the examination period.

Students who expect to be absent for an examination must negotiate alternative arrangements through the class teacher. This will require the completion of an application for Special Provision and a supplementary assessment task. Students who miss an examination due to an unexpected absence must make immediate contact with the House Coordinator.

All students with outstanding assessments (including missed examinations) will be required to complete supplementary assessments during available sessions within the examination block and immediately following the Graduation Liturgy on Thursday 16 November. Class teachers and/or the House Coordinator will advise students of these arrangements as necessary.
