- students who study Prevocational Mathematics will not have an examination in the afternoon session on Thursday 23 November
- students who study English Communication will not have an examination in the morning session on Thursday 23 November
- students who study both Prevocational Mathematics and English Communication and who have no outstanding assessments will not be required to attend on Thursday 23 November
- **Year 10 students who have no outstanding assessments will not be required to attend on Friday 24 November.**

Students unable to make arrangements to vary attendance to coincide with examinations will undertake study in classrooms under the direction of supervising teachers.

Students may not leave the College grounds between the morning and afternoon sessions.
